



**Growth Group discussion questions for Genesis 1**  
**Week of Feb. 11-14, 2018**

1. NCC Q23: Why must the Redeemer be truly God?  
*A: That because of his divine nature his obedience and suffering would be perfect and effective; and also that he would be able to bear the righteous anger of God against sin and yet overcome death.*  
**Memorize**, meditate on and be ready to recite Acts 2:24.
2. What principles or thoughts had the most impact on you from the message on this passage on Sunday, February 11<sup>th</sup>? How were you specifically challenged? What points of application did you take away from the message?
3. Read Genesis 1 at least twice.
4. It's very clear from the very beginning of the Bible how everything was created. According to these verses, specifically who created: v. 1-2; Isaiah 64:8, Job 33:4, Col. 1:15-17, Heb. 1:1-3?
5. Bible scholars insist that God created everything "ex nihilo," or out of nothing. What do you see in Gen. 1 that supports this point?
6. What was God's attitude toward what he created in vv. 10, 12, 18, 21, 31? Why?
7. God has revealed himself to mankind in a variety of ways. One way is through what is known as General Revelation. What is General Revelation? Does General Revelation tell what we need to know in order to have a right relationship with God? If not, what else must God reveal?
